

STUDENT-MEMBERS OF THE SCHOOL BOARD

The Board may choose to add one or more student members from the District high school. Student-members will serve one-year terms. Student-members will not have the right to vote. Student-members will be excluded from all non-public sessions the Board enters.

Student-members interested in school board student representation will submit a letter of interest to the high school principal. Candidates will be chosen by a vote of the high school student body, in accordance with the provisions of RSA 194:23-f.

Student-members are expected to:

1. Participate in an orientation with the high school principal;
2. Attend one meeting per month;
3. Represent all high school students within the District;
4. Present to the school board specific proposals and ideas from the high school student body;
5. Serve as a liaison between students, District staff, and the Board; and
6. Keep the student body informed of Board business and actions;
7. Comply with all Board policies relative to students and Board members, when applicable.

The Board reserves the right to discontinue the addition of student-members at any time.
