

EMPLOYEE JOB ACTIONS

It should be understood that the School Board and administration judge any work stoppage by school district employees to be an illegal act. With this premise as a basis, the philosophy of the Board and administration will be to keep school open so long as the health and safety of the students and staff can be assured. In the event that any work stoppage action should become an imminent threat to the health and safety of the students and staff, an alternate plan of action will be immediately enforced.

Action Regarding Work Stoppage

The initial decision as to whether or not schools will remain open will be made by the Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee in consultation with the Chairperson of the School Board. If this consultation is not possible, the Superintendent or his/her designee is authorized to make the decision.

The decision as to what schools will remain open will be made by the Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee after consultation with the Chairperson of the School Board. If this consultation is not possible, the Superintendent or his/her designee is authorized to make the decision.
