

FIELD TRIPS AND EXCURSIONS

Private car field trips are discouraged. When a small group goes on a trip in private cars, each car must be driven by an adult. Prior approval to use private cars must be obtained from the principal. School insurance does not cover or protect anyone driving their own automobile on a field trip.

Bicycle trips cannot be scheduled as the school insurance policies do not cover this mode of transportation.

It is expected that appropriate dress will be enforced as determined by the teacher in charge.

When appropriate, a first aide kit or a qualified first aid person should be present.

All students must attend a field trip when their class is scheduled except in case of emergency.

There should be at least one chaperone for every 5 to 25 students, with the appropriate number determined by age of students, type of activity, and location of activity.

Bus transportation arrangements are to be made with the school district's bus supervisor. Pre-scheduled athletic events may take precedence.

Walking field trips are permissible providing slips are signed; principal's permission has been granted and a written note left with the secretary.
