

INTERDISCIPLINARY CREDIT

High school students may earn course credit in one content area required for graduation, and apply said credit in a different content area through the awarding of interdisciplinary credit. Interdisciplinary credit may be counted only once in meeting graduation requirements.

The high school Principal is charged with approving courses for interdisciplinary credit if: (1) the course has been adopted by the Berlin High School Administrative Council; and (2) the course addresses the objectives for the subject area in which the credit is to be counted.
