

ADMISSION OF RESIDENT STUDENTS

The school district of residence of a student is defined by RSA 193:12, II.

New Resident Students

All new resident students, accompanied by a parent/guardian, should register at school before opening day and as early as possible.

Children entering the Berlin Public Schools for the first time must have:

- Legal address, proof of residency via rent receipt, utility bills, lease agreement...
- Child's original birth certificate
- Immunization records
- Copy of the child's most recent physical
- Social Security card
- Parenting Plan/Custody/Restraining Orders if applicable

Principals or their designees will meet with new children and parents to explain school programs. Students must be 5 years old by September 30 in order to register for Kindergarten. Registration for kindergartners and grade 1 students takes place in the spring for the following September.
