

LONG TERM TEACHER SUBSTITUTE COMPENSATION

The rate of pay for a substitute for the first ten consecutive school days shall be set by the School Board and subject to periodic review.

Whenever a fully qualified substitute is required for a period in excess of ten consecutive school days, the substitute will have full responsibility for the instruction to include planning lessons and grading students, and such a substitute will be placed on a per diem based on 1/185th of step one of the teachers' salary for the district in which he/she is substituting beginning with the eleventh day. If the individual is not certified to teach in the area for which they are substituting, notification as required by NHDOE will be done.
